Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 19-3-19 and Section 25-41-1 et seq., of the Mississippi Code of 1972, that during its **Recessed Meeting** on **Monday, April 18, 2022, beginning at 9:00 a.m.**, in its Board Room on the First Floor of the Raymond P. Davis County Annex Building, the Lauderdale County Board of Supervisors will discuss and intends to vote whether to opt out of allowing the cultivation, processing, sale and/or distribution of medical cannabis and cannabis products.

The Board of Supervisors will do so in the form of a **Public Hearing** during which members of the public will have an opportunity to express their views on the subject. The **Public Hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. during the Recessed Meeting.**

By law, the Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County may opt out of allowing one or more of the following: cultivation, processing, sale or distribution of medical cannabis and cannabis products.
