

Guidance on Cleaning and Removing Storm Debris for Lauderdale County Residents

Lauderdale County has recently been in the path of some serious storms leaving behind fallen trees, tree limbs, and other debris.

Removing storm debris is labor intensive and redirects our maintenance teams from completing various projects around the county. To help everyone, our Road and Bridge department will **only** remove storm debris in the affected areas of the county.

Here is what county residents can expect following a storm.

- Weather permitting, a storm assessment will be made to determine the affected area of the county. This identified area will be published on our website <https://lauderdalecounty.org/> and on our Road and Bridge Department Facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/LauderdaleCountyRoad>
- Specific instructions will be provided to our residents of the identified area. These instructions will include the timeframe for this removal opportunity and how to request removal.

If you have storm debris, and you reside outside of the identified affected area, you can safely burn the debris or haul it to our local landfills.
